### WHAT IS SCALE ACCELERATOR?

**Spring Impact** (formerly known as The International Centre for Social Franchising), is an organisation with a singular focus on scaling social impact. We support truly transformative social impact projects to develop the strategic plans, systems and processes they need to become scalable - reaching many more people.

We launched the first ever Scale Accelerator programme in 2015, providing UK based organisations with the support and expertise they needed to scale their social innovations. Over the past three years, with support from a range of funders, we have worked with promising social innovations that deal with a range of issues from homelessness to youth leadership, to develop a strategy and model for scaling their impact. To date, 17 organisations from across the country have taken part.

Whilst there are a range of resources focused on supporting innovation, developing new ideas, or supporting organisations to grow, Scale Accelerator uniquely focuses on scaling impact rather than supporting organisational growth. In 2019, we are launching our third Scale Accelerator and over the next three years we will support four Scale Accelerator cohorts. We are now looking for ambitious organisations with exciting social innovations to join our first cohort.



### WHAT WILL I GET FROM TAKING PART?

#### Bespoke consultancy support

Spring Impact's experienced team will provide nine months of bespoke consultancy support, guiding your organisation through a proven approach to scale. Through a series of workshops and meetings, we will co-develop:

- an ambitious strategy for scale
- the design of how you will operationalise the strategy
- an accompanying financial model.

After the initial nine months of support, we will continue to work with you as you implement your scale strategy. We will provide flexible bespoke support and give you the opportunity to attend learning events with the wider Scale Accelerator cohort.

#### **SHOULD I APPLY?**

We are looking for UK-based organisations that are able to meet the majority of the following:

- are addressing a pressing social need
- are meaningfully engaging people with lived experience of the issue you are trying to address
- have some evidence of impact (either qualitative or quantitative)
- have received demand from potential partners or funders
- would likely be successful in new locations
- have stable sources of funding.

Scale Accelerator is an intensive programme that requires your organisation's senior leadership team to collaborate with us to develop your scale strategy and business model. We are therefore looking for teams that are able to commit to participating in approximately five workshops, in addition to monthly meetings throughout the course of the programme.

#### **Tailored expertise**

Along the journey, you will also receive support from our partner organisations to address your specific challenges to get ready to scale. We will work with you to identify where your organisation could benefit from additional support and allocate existing budget to enable you to access expertise. For example, organisations may access support to develop their monitoring and evaluation, or marketing.

#### Work alongside and learn from like-minded organisations

As part of a cohort, your organisation will have the opportunity to attend learning events and share best practice with other social sector leaders also working to scale their social innovations.
